2027-2030: Industry experts predict 35-60% of urban ride-hailing shifts to autonomous vehicles.

CHAPTER 2: HOW TO START YOUR EMERGENCY TRANSPORT BUSINESS

The Smart Transition: Two-Track Strategy

Don't quit Uber tomorrow. Build your emergency transport business while you still earn income.

Month 1-3: Getting Started

Register with GodsOwnApp as:

1. **Reseller** - £36 +£6 = £42 / \$57
2. **Emergency App Driver Lite Package:** 150 licences with your branding - £270 / \$365
3. **Emergency App Driver Standard Package:** 300 licences with your branding - £525 / \$710

These licences are for use for building up a potential user base and be given either for free or for a nominal fee such as £2. Thereby fully recovering some of your early investment.

So what will an audience of 150 or 300 deliver you in terms of business during a year. Assuming 1/3 use our app and book your services at least once during a year and if you were to charge a minimum fee of £40 per hospital visit you'll make at worst £2,000/£4,000 If the first responders for the 150/300 decide to buy and install our app you will receive 4 times as much £8,000/£16,000

Payment for the 150/300 licenses can be paid in 3 instalments - £90 x 3 or £175 x 3.

You are now able to earn reseller commission at - £1.50 / \$2 Traveller License, £6 / \$8 Single User Licence and £12 / \$16 SME or Family License. To view full reseller plan benefits visit our website and read through the Resellers page. On an average month you should be able to make £950 / \$1283 as Reseller commission.

How your's will be the first cab before Uber or Lyft to be notified in an emergency.

When you are ordering an Emergency App Driver Lite or Standard package we will provide you with GPS sensing features which will alert our App user when you are within a 2 Mile radius to use your cab as the first priority. This guarantees you emergency ride bookings from our App users

Week 4-10: Get Certified

- **First Aid & CPR:** 8-16 hours, £148/\$150-200 (black cab drivers already have this so its not needed for them)
- **Defensive Driving:** 4-8 hours online, £60/ \$75-90
- **Bloodborne Pathogen Training:** 2-3 hours online, £60/\$90

Total investment: £270/\$320 and about 20 hours. If you are a black cab driver you'll only need to pay for the last 2 - £120 and roughly in terms of time - 10 hours

You can do these courses between Uber shifts or trips

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Week 10-14: Prepare Your Vehicle

Buy basic equipment

Medical Bag (£35/\$50):

- Disposable gloves
- Face masks
- Bandages and gauze
- Sick bags
- Hand sanitizer
- Emergency blanket
- Flashlight

Vehicle Modifications (£100/\$130):

- Waterproof seat covers
- Phone charger
- Disinfectant spray
- Small step stool (for elderly patients)

Comfort Items (£20/\$30):

- Bottled water
- Tissues
- Bags for patient belongings

Deep clean your vehicle—it's now a professional medical transport.

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Month 4-6: Build Your Client Base

Three Ways to Get Customers:

1. GodsOwnApp Platform

- Set yourself “available” during peak hours:
 - Evenings (6 PM-midnight)
 - Weekend afternoons
 - Early mornings (6-10 AM)
- Respond within 3 minutes
- Build your ratings
- Give away for free your brandrd App as many as 150/300 licenses to build cutomer base or charge £2 for it to recover your early investment

2. Healthcare Facilities

3. Visit in person (dress professionally):

- Dialysis centers
- Chemotherapy clinics
- Urgent care centers
- Nursing homes
- Hospital discharge departments

Your pitch: “I provide professional emergency transport for patients who can’t afford ambulances. I’m First Aid and CPR certified, fully insured, and available 24/7.”

Goal: Get 2-3 facilities sending you regular patients.

3. Community Outreach

Distribute flyers at:

- Senior centers
- Churches/community centers
- Social services agencies

Your flyer headline: “Need Emergency Medical Transport? Can’t Afford Ambulance Costs?”

Your Services	Typical Cost	Ambulance Cost
Emergency transport (10 miles)	£50-70 / \$70-90	£300-500 / \$400-1,200
Time commitment	45 minutes average	Same service, 5-10x price

How to Handle Emergency Calls

When you get a call:

Accept immediately (within 3 minutes)

Call the patient while driving to them:

- Confirm exact location
- Ask if they can walk with help
- Ask if they're stable
- Reassure them: "I'm 6 minutes away, I'm certified, I'll get you there safely"

Arrive professionally:

- Park safely
- Grab medical bag
- Introduce yourself calmly

Quick assessment (30 seconds):

- Are they conscious?
- Can they walk with help?
- **Any severe distress** (trouble breathing, chest pain, severe bleeding)?

If severe: "I'm calling 911/999 right now—you need an ambulance"

Safe transport:

- Help them to car
- Secure seatbelt
- Drive safely (not recklessly)
- Check on them: "How are you feeling?"

At the facility:

- Help them inside
- Make sure they're checked in

After:

- Disinfect surfaces
- Ask for review/testimonial

This becomes natural after 5-10 transports.

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What to Charge

Recommended Pricing:

- **Base rate:** £20-40 / \$40-65 for first 5 miles
- **Plus:** £3-4 / \$4-5 per additional mile

Typical trips:

- 5 miles: £20-40 / \$30-50
- 10 miles: £50-70 / \$70-90
- 20 miles: £75-100 / \$110-140

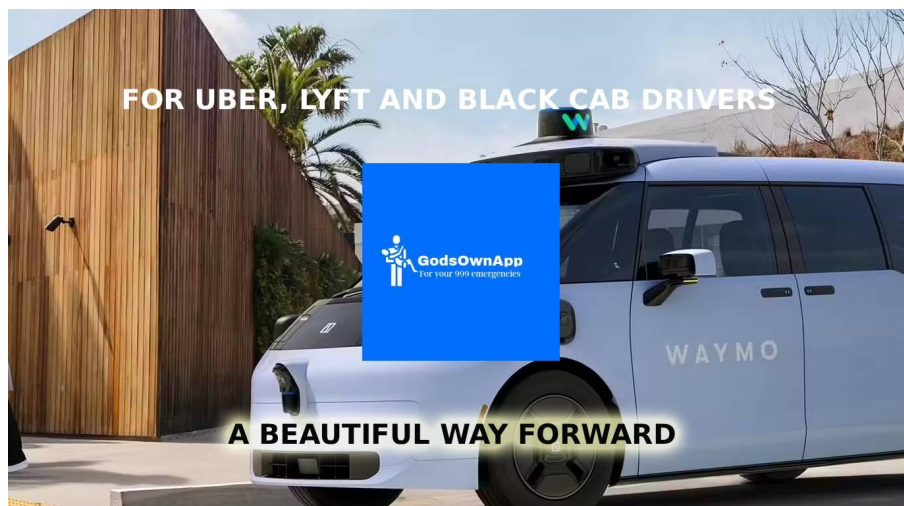
Minimum charge: £40-50 / \$50-65 (covers your time)

Package deals for regular patients:

- 10 rides: 10% discount
- Monthly unlimited (dialysis 3x/week): £450-550 / \$650-850

Uber/Lyft	30 hours weekly x 4.33	£1,949 / \$2,632
Emergency Transport	45 hours (26 trips @ £40/\$54)	£1,040 / \$1,405
Reseller commission	Monthly	£950 / \$1283

TOTAL	45 hours	£4,660 / \$6,310

CHAPTER 3: MULTIPLY YOUR INCOME-THE RESELLER MODEL

From Driver to Business Builder

After 6 months of emergency transport, you understand the business. Now **multiply your income** by helping other drivers make the same transition.

How GodsOwnApp Reseller Works

Two options:

4. **Lite Package:** 150 licenses with your branding - £250 / \$340
5. **Standard Package:** 300 licenses with your branding - £440 / \$595

Your role: Recruit and mentor drivers. You earn:

Who to Recruit

Look for:

- Professional drivers (4.8+ star ratings)
- Driving 1+ years, planning to continue
- Actually care about passengers
- Working full-time (need the income)
- In your area

Where to find them:

- Uber/Lyft driver Facebook groups
- Driver forums and Discord servers
- Staging areas (airport lots, downtown waiting spots)
- Gas stations near ride-hailing zones

How to Recruit

Don't spam. Have real conversations.

Your opening: “How long have you been driving? Ever thought about what happens when self-driving cars take over? I’ve been building a backup plan in emergency medical transport. Want to grab coffee and talk about it?”

Common objections (and your answers):

“I don’t have medical training.”

“Neither did I. First Aid and CPR took one weekend and cost £100/\$150. That’s it.”

“Sounds risky.”

“You’re transporting people just like Uber—but to hospitals. If someone’s really sick, you call 911. The training covers this.”

“How do I get customers?”

“The GodsOwnApp platform connects you with patients. Plus I’ll teach you exactly how to get regular clients from dialysis centers and clinics. I’ll mentor you through everything.”

“Sounds like a pyramid scheme.”

“You’re not buying products. You’re not selling to friends. You’re starting an independent emergency transport business. I just help you get set up and mentor you—that’s why I earn a small fee.”

The Ride-Along: Your Strongest Recruiting Tool

When prospects see you:

- Respond professionally to emergency call
- Help a frightened elderly patient
- Transport them safely with compassion
- Receive genuine gratitude
- Get paid £60/\$75 for 45 minutes

They'll understand this is real.

Building Your 30-Driver Team

Month 6-12: Recruit 10 drivers

Month 12-18: Recruit 10 more (20 total)

Month 18-24: Recruit final 10 (30 total)

Support your team:

- Monthly team meetings (in-person or Zoom)
- WhatsApp group for real-time help
- Quarterly training sessions
- Celebrate successes

Your income at 30 drivers:

- Personal emergency transports: £1,200-2,000 / \$1,500-2,500 monthly
- Mentoring fees (30 × £24/\$33): **£720 / \$990 monthly**

Total: £2,100- 2,800/ \$3,140-4,790 monthly plus your normal Uber, Lyft or Black cab earnings at 50%.

And you've helped 30 people escape job displacement.

CHAPTER 4: SCALE TO REGIONAL IMPACT

Years 2-4: From Team to Enterprise

Once you have 30 drivers operating successfully, you can build regional coverage.

The opportunity: One mid-sized city (500,000 people) has 15,000-25,000 emergency transports annually that people can't afford or access.

Your 30-driver team can handle 6,000-9,000 annually. **There's room for 3-4x growth.**

Create Systems That Run Without You

Document everything:

1. **Recruit onboarding:** Step-by-step guide for new drivers
2. **Emergency transport procedures:** Complete protocols

One hospital = 50-60 transports monthly

Government contracts:

- UK: Partner with NHS Clinical Commissioning Groups
- US: Contract with county health departments
- Canada: Provincial health transport programs

Your pitch: “We handle non-life-threatening emergencies at £80-100 vs. £300-500 ambulance costs. This frees up ambulances for real emergencies.”

These contracts provide huge, stable volume.

Your Income at Scale (Years 5-7)

Personal income: £50K-80K / \$66K-105K annually

Business value: £500K- 600K / \$650K-1M (saleable asset)

You've built healthcare infrastructure that robots can't replace.
